 - Vision

 - Generational ministry
 - Laborer
2. Using both the Old and New Testament, find passages of scripture that *refer* to the concept of 3 and 4 generations - whether physical or spiritual – whether positive or negative.
3. Using both the Old and New Testament, find passages of scripture that *illustrate* characters with 3, 4, 5, and 6 generation chains (*spiritual* linkage preferred).
4. Read 2 Timothy and answer the following questions:
 - How do the illustrations of the soldier, athlete, and farmer relate to the vision of spiritual generations?
 - What must a person do to multiply his life over the long time?
 - What characteristics should be manifested in your life to ensure that God would desire to reproduce your life in another?
5. If you were to develop a plan to implement the Navigator vision in your context, what would it look like? What would you believe God for? What promises might you claim?
6. In 200 words or less, write a “conviction statement” based on 2 Timothy 2:2 and its application to the vision of spiritual generations. Using 50 words or less, indicate the significance of that statement for your future ministry.
